The team now has 9 members who are currently developing the protocols, data base and other documentary and information framework within which the Neighbourhood Plan will be developed.

There was a further group meeting early July followed by a training day for team members at the Village Hall on Saturday 27th July which will be delivered by Helen Metcalfe, a professional Planner who specialises in advising and assisting with the preparation of Neighbourhood Plans.

Items of Interest!

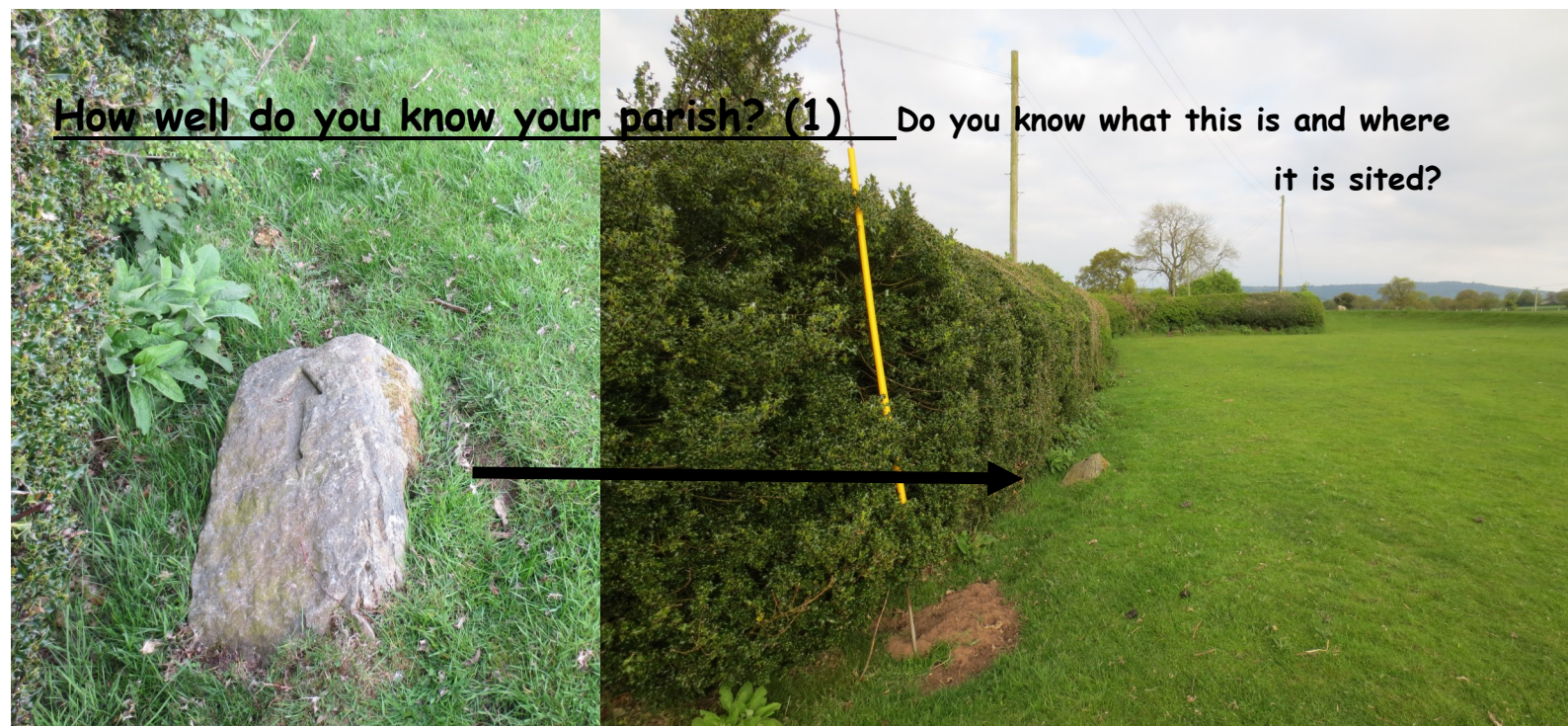
The Parish Council are pleased to announce that Wharf Lane has finally been resurfaced after more than 10 years of being on the list of things that needed doing in the parishes!
