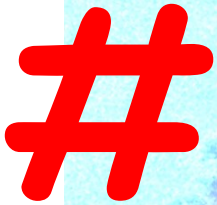


Items of Interest.

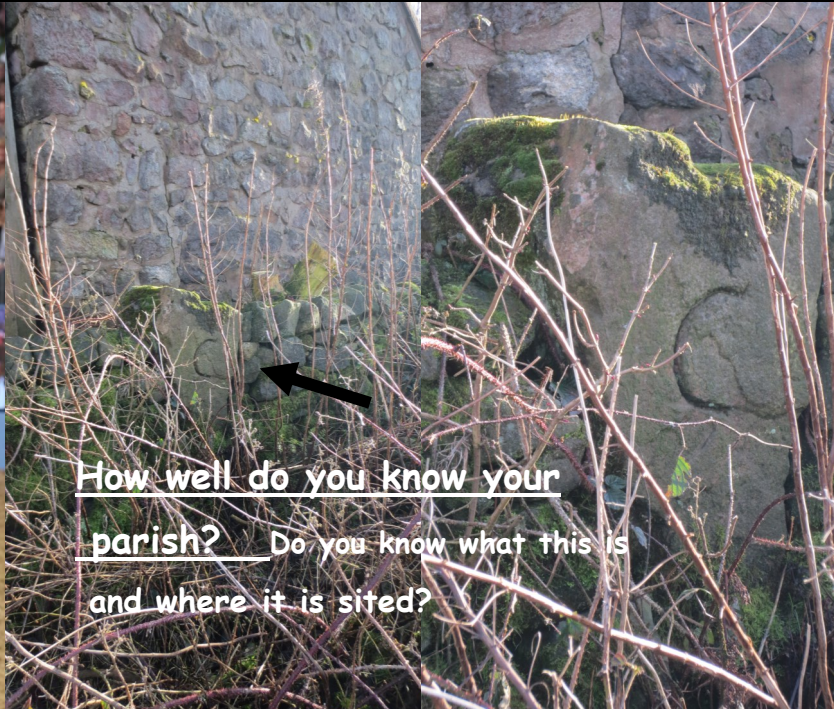

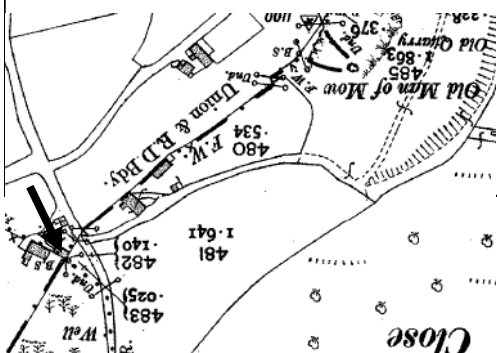
