### Neighbourhood Plan

The Project Group have now received confirmation of support from Cheshire East Council, in assisting with preparing the Neighbourhood Plan, and which will consist of the input and guidance from a Chartered Town Planner and CCA Officer.

The first session between the Project Group and the CEC Support Programme is scheduled for 22nd October from which a sequence of development steps and programme taking the plan forward will be prepared.

Although the Project Group now comprises 8 members, four of whom are Parish Councillors, it is still keen to increase numbers and residents and stake holders who are willing to assist in any way with the administration and preparation of the Plan.
