**Neighbourhood Plan Updates.**

The Astbury & Moreton Neighbourhood Plan Group have been progressing, with regular meetings, the preliminary stages of the plan. Negotiations are underway with Cheshire East Council in the precise extent of the area designation but this is expected to be cleared before the end of the year and registered under the Localism Act with which Cheshire East are obliged to comply.

The Group is pressing for the full extent of the Parishes of Astbury & Moreton to be included in the designated area as indicated on the attached plan showing the extent of the Parishes.

A training day for Group Members was held on Saturday 27th July in Astbury Village Hall conducted by Helen Metcalfe, MA, MRTPI, a consultant who outlined the process and stages of developing the Plan and is shadowing its progress.

An Open Morning has been scheduled for 9.30am - 12.00noon at Astbury Village Hall on the 9th November when plans, reference material and protocol data will be available for review and comment. Parishioners are urged to attend and contribute their views and wishes which will be materially relevant to the emerging Neighbourhood Plan. Group Members will be on hand to explain the scope and procedures in developing the plan and which when adopted will significantly affect the future of the Parish and its Residents.
